

# Chronic Care Management & Remote Patient Monitoring Services

## What is Chronic Care Management & Remote Patient Monitoring Services?

CCM/RPM services may be furnished for Medicare patients with two or more chronic conditions who are at significant risk of death, acute exacerbation/decompensation, or functional decline.

**All allowed Chronic Care Management Codes & Remote Therapeutic Monitoring: are Coded and billed as G0511**

As of Jan 2024 - RHC's may bill HCPC code G0511 multiple times in a calendar month, as long as all of the requirements are met and resource costs are not counted more than once.
